

TEHAMA COUNTY TRANSIT AGENCY BOARD MINUTES OF SEPTEMBER 29, 2009

Present: Directors': George Russell; Gary Strack; Robert Christison; Charles Willard; and Ron Warner. Absent: Director Jim Byrne. Also present: Barbara O'Keeffe, Deputy Director of Public Works - Transportation.

10. **CALL TO ORDER:** Chairman Russell opened the meeting at 9:05 a.m.

Barbara O'Keeffe distributed a flyer from the Susanville Indian Rancheria Public Transportation Program. The tribe applied and received Federal funds for this project which will begin in Susanville, come to the Red Bluff Transit Center and then on to Redding. The round-trip will be provided free of charge at this time. They anticipate that during winter season the routes and/or times will change. Currently, they are running Monday, Tuesday and Thursday's.
